

LEGAL NOTICE

Sealed bids in regards to the **Shannon Road Left Turn Lane Improvement and Signalization Plan, a.k.a. "Shannon Road School Zone Safety Project"** for the Trumbull County Engineer's Department will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Trumbull County, State of Ohio, at the office of the Board in the County Administration Building, 160 High Street, N.W., Warren, Ohio, until **11: 00 a.m.** Warren, Ohio Time, on **March 12, 2010.** and shall be opened and read on the same day thereafter.

Copies of the bid package are on file in the office of the Trumbull County Engineer, 650 North River Road, Warren, Ohio, where they may be obtained or examined.

There is established a fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for said bid package which is non-refundable.

Bids must be made on the Bid Blank prescribed by the County and shall be filed in a sealed envelope at the time and place hereinbefore designated. Each bid shall contain the full name and address of each person or company submitting same and shall be accompanied by a certified check on a solvent bank, or a bid bond, in the sum of not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted a contract will be entered into in the proper manner. The check or bid bond of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned to them by the contracting authority immediately upon awarding the contract or rejection of all bids.

Bidders are required to comply with the Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) requirements set forth in Section 164.07 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Rule 164.132 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, The Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Trumbull County, Ohio, as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

The attention of the bidders is directed to the requirement that each proposal must be accompanied by a Non-Collusion Affidavit duly signed by the bidder.

Attention is also directed to all bidders that Trumbull County adopted a "Drug and Alcohol Free Workplace Policy" on July 14, 2004, and the terms of this policy also apply to any Contractors directly reimbursed for services through the County; a copy of Policy to be part of proposal, and that each proposal be accompanied by a "Sign-Off Sheet" duly signed by the bidder thereof.

Attention is also directed to all bidders that a signed and executed Declaration Regarding Material Assistance/No Assistance to a Terrorist Organization must be submitted as part of the proposal in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code Section 2909.33 and the Ohio Division of Homeland Security.

Attention is also directed to all bidders that a signed Contribution Affidavit must be submitted as part of the proposal in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 3517, effective April 4, 2007.

Attention is also directed to all bidders that pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 307.86 and 307.87, effective September 26, 2003, this notice of bid will be published one time only, with the condition that this notice has been posted on the County's Internet Site on the worldwide web and found at <http://www.demandstar.com/>. The Trumbull County Commissioners reserve the right to accept or reject any or all bids, and to delete any part of the proposal herein.
